AWARD

Upon providing all parties with an opportunity to be heard, having examined his jurisdiction and considered the factual and legal arguments as well as the requests for relief submitted in this case, the Arbitrator decides as follows:

- 1. AEK Athens BSA shall pay Mr. Edin Atic EUR 87,500.00, as unpaid amounts arising from a termination agreement, plus interest at 5% per annum
 - a. from 1 February 2019 until payment in respect of EUR 62,500.00,
 - b. from 1 March 2019 until payment in respect of EUR 12,500.00, and
 - c. from 1 April 2019 until payment in respect of EUR 12,500.00.
- 2. AEK Athens BSA shall pay Mr. Edin Atic EUR 9,700.00, as a penalty fee for the late payments.
- 3. The costs of this arbitration until the present Award, which were determined by the President of the BAT to be in the amount of EUR 5,950.00, shall be borne by AEK Athens BSA. Accordingly, AEK Athens BSA shall pay to Mr. Edin Atic EUR 5.950.00. The balance of the Advance on Costs, in the amount of EUR 1,050.00, will be reimbursed to Mr. Edin Atic by the BAT.
- 4. AEK Athens BSA shall pay Mr. Edin Atic EUR 5,500.00 as a contribution to his legal fees and expenses.
- 5. Any arbitration costs associated with a Request for Reasons (see attached Notice) shall be advanced and borne by the requesting party.

Notice about Request for Reasons

in accordance with Articles 16.2 of the BAT Rules:

"By agreeing to submit their dispute to arbitration under these Rules, the Parties agree that, where the value of the dispute does not exceed EUR 100,000, the Arbitrator shall issue an award without reasons, provided, however, that the Arbitrator shall deliver reasons if a party

- a) files a request to that effect at any stage from when the Request for Arbitration is filed until no later than ten (10) days after the notification of the award without reasons; and
- b) pays the respective advance on costs as determined and within the time limit set by the BAT Secretariat."

The Parties are herewith informed that the amount to be paid as an advance on costs for a reasoned award in this case has been set by the BAT Secretariat to **EUR 5,000.00**. The time limit for payment thereof will be set by the BAT Secretariat upon receipt of the Request for Reasons, if any.
